Questions

1. In [Psalm 57:1](#) David sought refuge with God. Dave shared a story of when he managed an emergency triage team in London during the London 7/7 bombings. He had to escape to the privacy of the toilets to get some space to be with God. Where do you go practically to seek refuge with God during difficult times?
2. In [Psalm 56:8](#) we read how God watches over us and know all the pain we go through. How should this encourage us when we feel the pressure of life?
3. We are reminded in [John 16:33](#) how God is Sovereign over all things even the most pressurised situations we go through. How does this make you feel and why?
4. Dave highlighted our reward from scripture in [Psalm 126:5](#). Tears appear at the most difficult times when we are broken and hurt, often feeling crushed. But its at this point that God provides this promise. What goes through your mind when you read this?

Application

Some of the worlds most precious diamonds are formed deep within the Earth's mantle under extreme conditions, at depths ranging from 150 to 200km, and temperatures of over 1,000 degrees Celsius. The transformation process can take years creating a most beautiful and costly gem. We read in [Proverbs 3:5-18](#) how we are considered MORE precious than jewels. Pray for each other that we are able to walk with God through the pressures of life trusting in Him as we become more precious than diamonds.
